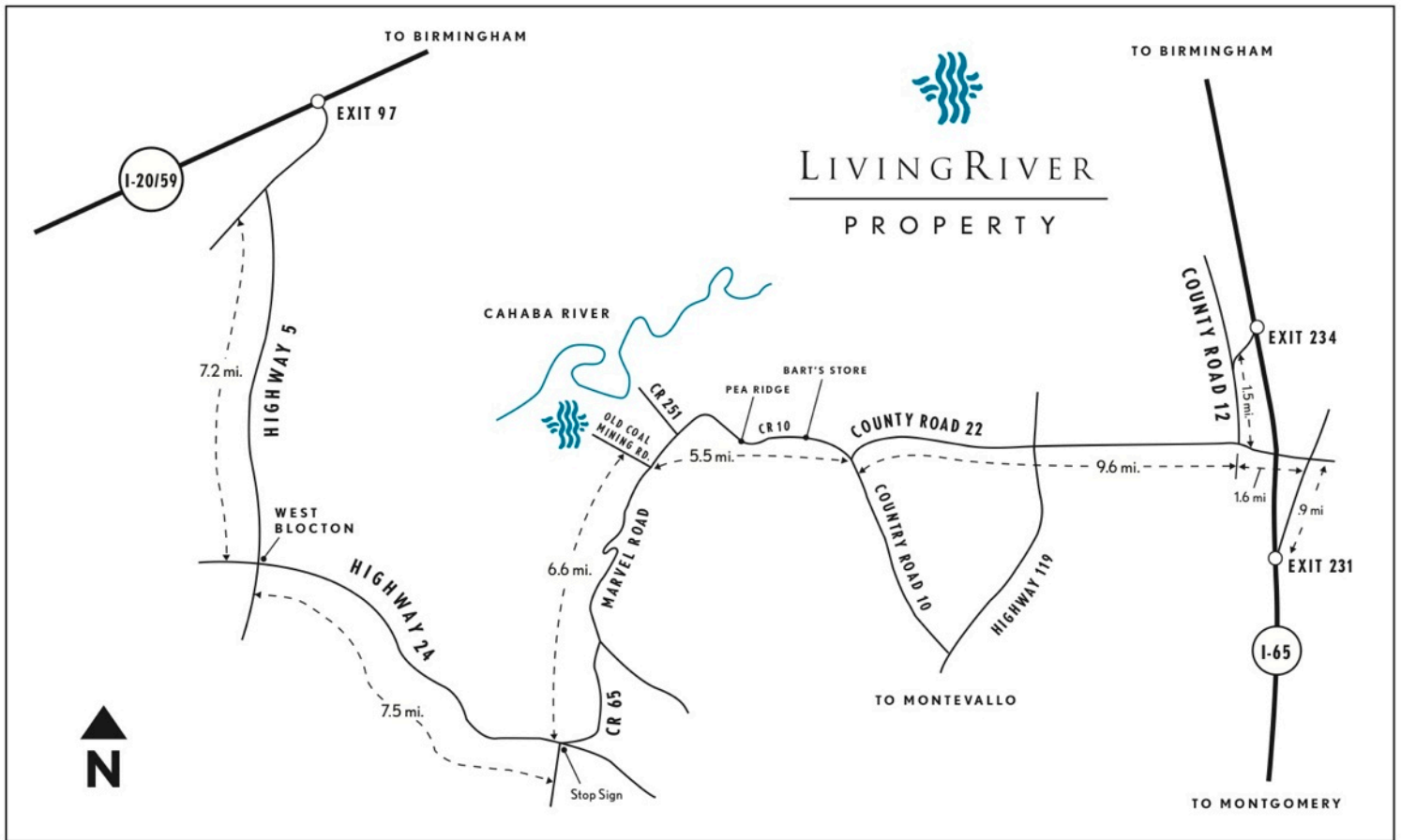
**Phyllis Ward**

**FROM THE NORTH (I-65)**

South on I-65 to Exit 234 (Shelby Co. Airport)  
 Left on CR-12 for 1.5 miles until it deadends  
 Right on CR-22 for 9.6 miles until it deadends  
 Right on CR-10 for 5.5 miles  
 When you see CR-251 on the Right continue on CR-10 for .8 miles  
 Turn Right on an old paved coal truck road. Living River is several miles back.

**FROM THE SOUTH (I-65)**

North on I-65 to Exit 231  
 Right on HWY 31 for 0.9 miles  
 Left on CR-22 for 11.2 miles until it deadends  
 Right on CR-10 for 5.5 miles  
 When you see CR-251 on the Right continue on CR-10 for .8 miles  
 Turn Right on an old paved coal truck road. Living River is several miles back.

**FROM I-20/59**

From I-20/59 take Exit 97, proceed southwest for 3 miles  
 Left on HWY 5 for 7.2 miles  
 DO NOT turn Left toward the "Business District," but instead turn Left onto HWY 24 for 7.5 miles toward West Blocton  
 At stop sign veer Left onto CR-65 for 6.6 miles. (CR-65 changes names to "Marvel Road")  
 Turn Left on an old paved coal truck road. Living River is several miles back.
